I have seen way too many motorcycle fatalities in the last couple of months. Many of us have lost friends or relatives in these accidents. Impaired drivers, left turns, u-turns, speeding, out running the law, and the list goes on of needless causes.

I was warned of this situation back in March, when I attended the Ride SMART Course in Gainesville. The officers conducting the course predicted a “Perfect Storm” brewing as the COVID restrictions were being lifted. People who had been couped up would be getting out. There had been fewer deputies working the road and those working were less likely to stop people for infractions. They predicted a rise in accidents and fatalities over the Summer, as people got out.

We need to recognize the increased danger and adjust our riding to compensate for the idiots out there. Don't be idiots ourselves and add to the chance of an accident. Be on the defense and have an offense prepared to escape danger when it appears. We must be responsible for the outcome.

We must also continue the fight to protect motorcyclists' right and improve motorcycle safety. This mission will never end for us. The need for ABATE did not end with the passage of House Bill 1911 in 2000. ABATE will be a relevant organization now and in the years to come.

Our hearts and prayers go out to the families and friends of all the motorcyclists that we have lost.

I wish all of you riding to Sturgis a safe trip.
