Legislative Report

Greetings Fellow Members and Supporters! Here are some Florida Legislative updates.

The 2021 Legislative Session convened on Tuesday, March 2, 2021 and is scheduled to conclude on Friday, April 30, 2021

Current updates on the VRU and Safety Money Bills as of April 12th 2021

SB278 introduced by Senator Baxley - Traffic Offenses; Creating the “Vulnerable Road User Act”; providing criminal penalties for a person who commits a moving violation that causes serious bodily injury to, or causes the death of, a vulnerable road user; requiring that the person who commits the moving violation pay a specified fine, serve a minimum period of house arrest, and attend a driver improvement course; requiring that the court revoke the person’s driver license for a minimum specified period, etc.

Effective Date: 10/1/2021 (if passed)

Last Action: 3/2/2021 Senate - Introduced -SJ 57 (Appropriations)

HB1643 introduced by Representative McClain - Violations Against Vulnerable Road Users: Provides criminal penalties for person who commits moving violation that causes serious bodily injury to or death of vulnerable road user; requires person to pay specified fine, serve minimum period of house arrest, & attend driver improvement course; requires court to revoke person's driver license for minimum specified period; defines "vulnerable road user."

Effective Date: July 1, 2021 (if passed)

Last Event: Now in Criminal Justice & Public Safety Subcommittee on Friday, March 5, 2021 4:40 PM

HB2489 introduced by Representative McClain - Abate of Florida Safety & Education, Inc.: Provides an appropriation for the Abate of Florida Safety & Education, Inc. (Safety Money)

Effective Date: July 1, 2021 (if passed)

Last Event: Now in Appropriations Committee on Wednesday, March 17, 2021 2:26 PM

Other Legislation passed by Senate during this session:

April 8, 2021 - Legislation to Modernize, Safeguard the Florida Retirement System

April 8, 2021 - Legislation to Improve Career Planning Opportunities in Higher Education

April 7, 2021 - Expedite Water Storage North of Lake Okeechobee

April 7, 2021 - Comprehensive Plan to Invest in Florida’s Infrastructure

April 7, 2021 - Legislation to Stabilize Florida’s Property Insurance Market

INJURED MOTORCYCLIST AWARDED A \$9.6 MILLION VERDICT

On November 11, 2018, Joe S. was riding his motorcycle at a lawful rate of speed south bound on North Citrus Avenue in Crystal River, Florida and had the right of way. A north bound sport utility vehicle turned left in front of Joe S. violating his right of way. Joe S. and his motorcycle slammed into the passenger side of the sport utility vehicle and he sustained severe facial lacerations and multiple fractures to his left arm and pelvis. First – Responders called for Joe S. to be transported by Life Flight helicopter immediately to Ocala Regional Medical Center’s Level Two Trauma Center. Doctors and staff there saved Joe S.’s life and performed multiple surgeries on his face, left arm and pelvis. After seven weeks in ORMC, Joe S. was discharged home into the care of family members. His serious and permanent injuries, have had a profoundly adverse effect on his quality of life.

Ocala personal injury and motorcycle accident lawyer, Dan Hightower, filed a negligence lawsuit on behalf of his client, Joe S. in Citrus County, Florida in 2019. During the week of February 10, 2020, Mr. Hightower tried the case in Citrus County Circuit Court. After the conclusion of the trial, a verdict was rendered by the Court in favor of Joe S. and against the Defendant SUV driver for \$9,661,232.98.

When asked for comment on the verdict, Mr. Hightower simply said two things: 1) “Justice was served” and 2) “Watch out for motorcycles.”

BEWARE OF WET RIDING CONDITIONS

Be alert of dangerous road conditions in order to navigate the streets safely



Reduced Traction

Rain unveils oils that create slippery, wet surfaces that reduces the traction on your tires. Try to avoid riding on painted lines, manhole covers, tar snakes, puddles, and metal crossings. When possible, ride behind the vehicle's tire tracks, as they have already propelled some of the water away and allow you to gain better traction.



Obscured Obstacles

Abundant rainfall can obscure potholes and uneven surfaces on the road that can be hazardous to your safety. Slow down as much as possible, squeeze your clutch, and coast through the puddle. At higher speed conditions, try to maintain your speed and avoid abrupt changes as it can reduce the traction of your motorcycle.



Decreased Visibility

Visibility is reduced for both motorcyclists and vehicles while riding in the rain. Consider wearing reflective and/or bright-colored riding gear to increase your visibility in the road. Adjust accordingly to weather conditions and practice riding defensively.



Increase Braking Distance

Braking distance should be increased due to the lack of traction on the wet roads. Ride as vertical as possible to allow your tires to have the best contact path with the road. While braking, apply a lighter application to the front brakes.



Lightning

If lightning strikes during your ride, find an indoor rest stop immediately and wait it out. Riding in the elements on a metal contraption during a thunderstorm is asking for trouble!

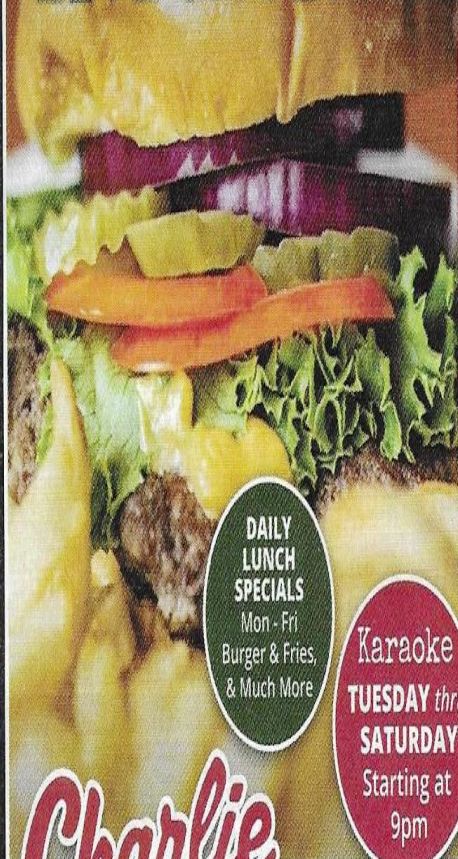
