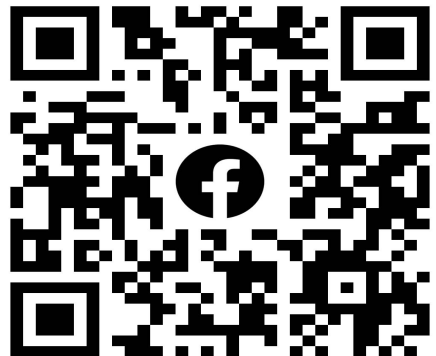

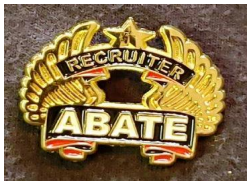

Greetings Fellow Members and Supporters!

Here is a short report on the annual ride to the State Capitol on February 14th, 2022 . I must first mention that it was a disappointment to see that only three people from our Chapter showed up for this most important event of the year. Our President John Melin, Vice President Bridgette Pace and I, the Legislative Trustee, were the only ones to ride with approximately 70 plus other motorcycles. The three of us rode up to Monticello on the Saturday before. We attended the State meeting on Sunday and then joined the ride on Monday. We also stayed one more additional night so that we could spend some more time seeing our Legislators and their Aides on Tuesday.

We learned quickly that House Bill 743 - Violations Against Vulnerable Road Users and Senate Bill 1252 - Traffic Offenses died in committees and never made it to the floor. House Bill 2573 – Safety and Education Money was not allocated specifically in the proposed budget. There is a slight chance we could still get some money but at this point, not likely.

Over the two days that we were at the Capitol, the three of us got to speak to Legislators, to include Rep. Stan McClain and Rep. Brannan as well as a few legislative aides. Much as we had learned before and have been told by our State ABATE Legislative Trustee and VP Darren “Scribe” Brooks, if you wait until the ride to the Capitol to put in a plea for our Bills, you are too late. As soon as our Bills are sponsored is the time to start communicating with our Legislators.

That being said, Forest Chapter President Melin suggested that we put together a committee early this year and organize a planned ride, possibly including other Chapters, to ride to the Capitol so that we can discuss early on the importance of our sponsored Bills.

There is a lot of truth to the proverbial saying, “The squeaky wheel gets the grease!” In the interest of our safety on our roads, we must all be a lot more active in pursuing our cause. That is the power of our Motorcycle Safety and Rights Organization! You can’t say that you truly are a legislative warrior for all bikers, if you just sit idly by.



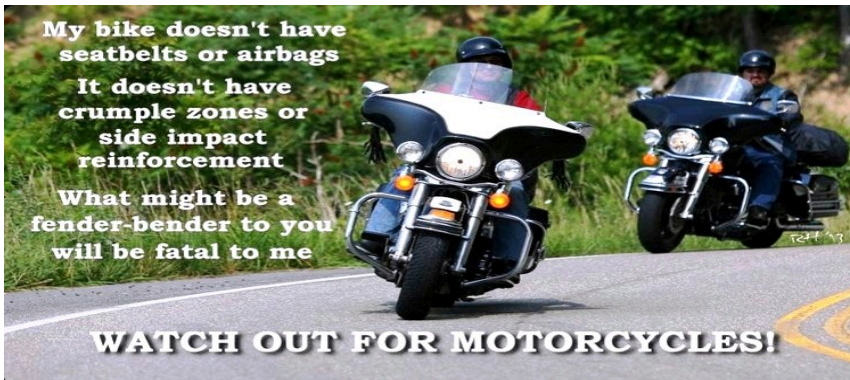

SOME NOTABLE TRIAL RESULTS!

\$9.6 MILLION VERDICT AWARDED TO INJURED MOTORCYCLIST

On November 11, 2018, Joe S. was riding his motorcycle at a lawful rate of speed south bound on North Citrus Avenue in Crystal River, Florida and had the right of way. A north bound sport utility vehicle turned left in front of Joe S. violating his right of way. Joe S. and his motorcycle slammed into the passenger side of the sport utility vehicle, and he sustained severe facial lacerations and multiple fractures to his left arm and pelvis. First – Responders called for Joe S. to be transported by Life Flight helicopter immediately to Ocala Regional Medical Center’s Level Two Trauma Center. Doctors and staff there saved Joe S.’s life and performed multiple surgeries on his face, left arm and pelvis. After seven weeks in ORM, Joe S. was discharged home into the care of family members. His serious and permanent injuries have had a profoundly adverse effect on his quality of life.

Ocala personal injury and motorcycle accident lawyer, Dan Hightower, filed a negligence lawsuit on behalf of his client, Joe S. in Citrus County, Florida in 2019. During the week of February 10, 2020, Mr. Hightower tried the case in Citrus County Circuit Court. After the conclusion of the trial, a verdict was rendered by the Court in favor of Joe S. and against the Defendant SUV driver for \$9,661,232.98.

When asked for comment on the verdict, Mr. Hightower simply said two things: 1) “Justice was served” and 2) “Watch out for motorcycles.”

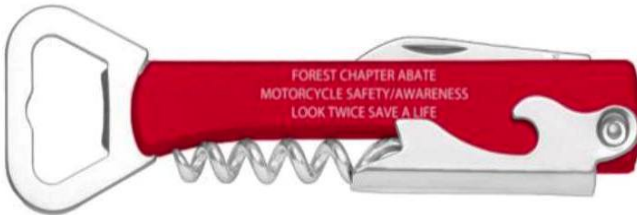

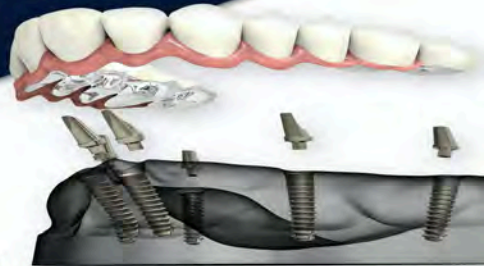

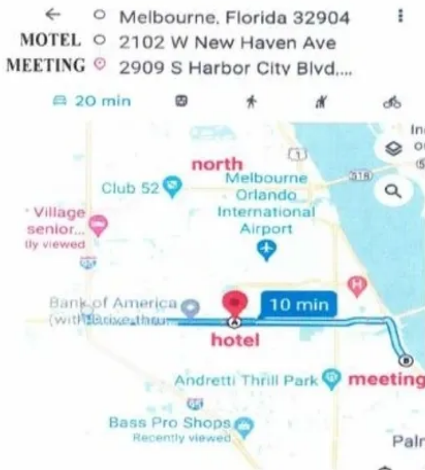
