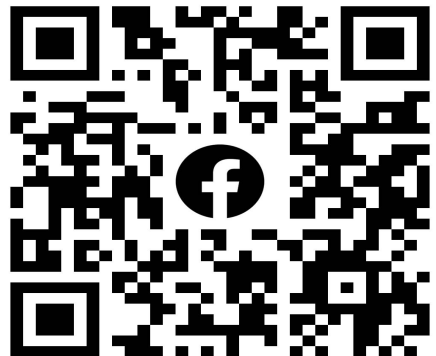

You are wondering how membership with ABATE works.....

You are 18yr old or older and have made the decision you want to be a member of a group that fights for bikers' rights and promotes motorcycle safety and awareness through education. You fill out the application with the all important signature along with either \$20 to become an annual member or \$600 for a lifetime member. You then either mail it to Forest Chapter ABATE PO Box 2409 Silver Springs Fl 34489 or give it to a member of the Board of Directors. (Don't worry if you don't know your voter districts and your +4 zip code). You are then a member of ABATE of Florida, Inc. after approval. All members receive a membership card with an expiration date, voting privileges in their home chapter (Forest), and monthly newsletter will be emailed to you. If you don't have an email and wish a monthly newsletter they are available at all our advertisers, monthly meeting and events the chapter participates at while supplies last. Otherwise they are mailed out quarterly to those without an email address. You will also have access to the state master link newsletter along with personal involvement in statewide legislative actions and your freedom to ride. It is also important that you fill out the bottom portion of the application because you also now have a \$4000 AD&D policy with American Income Life while you remain an active member of ABATE. You may change or add a second beneficiary any time all you need to do is contact your membership trustee for the form. As explained in the welcome letter from your membership trustee your annual membership card has an expiration date located on the left lower portion of your membership card. You will receive a letter approximately a month prior to your membership expiring. To avoid any interruption of your benefits, which include voting privileges and the AD&D policy you need to submit a completed application with the all important signature prior to the last day of the month of your expiration date. After the last day of the month of your expiration date you are considered delinquent member and your benefits are no longer active. However you have 30 days after the expiration date to submit an application with payment to become an active member and your benefits become active again. During your period as an active member any of your information changes please complete an application including the all important signature and give to the membership trustee so all your information can remain accurate. While you are an ABATE member make sure that someone in your family knows that you are a member so if the unfortunate event occurs that you are entitled to the insurance they can contact ABATE immediately because they only have a limited time to claim the insurance you are entitled. Also just a suggestion if your beneficiary is the person that usually rides with you, you may want to think about listing a second person in the event that tragedy strikes both of you at the same time. 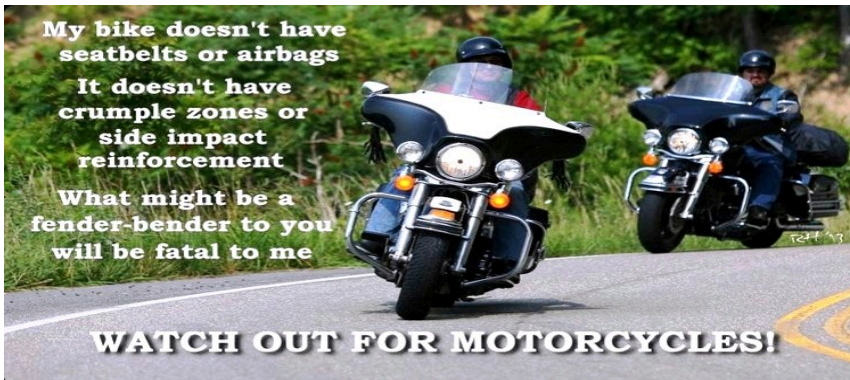

SOME NOTABLE TRIAL RESULTS!

\$9.6 MILLION VERDICT AWARDED TO INJURED MOTORCYCLIST

On November 11, 2018, Joe S. was riding his motorcycle at a lawful rate of speed south bound on North Citrus Avenue in Crystal River, Florida and had the right of way. A north bound sport utility vehicle turned left in front of Joe S. violating his right of way. Joe S. and his motorcycle slammed into the passenger side of the sport utility vehicle, and he sustained severe facial lacerations and multiple fractures to his left arm and pelvis. First – Responders called for Joe S. to be transported by Life Flight helicopter immediately to Ocala Regional Medical Center’s Level Two Trauma Center. Doctors and staff there saved Joe S.’s life and performed multiple surgeries on his face, left arm and pelvis. After seven weeks in ORM, Joe S. was discharged home into the care of family members. His serious and permanent injuries have had a profoundly adverse effect on his quality of life.

Ocala personal injury and motorcycle accident lawyer, Dan Hightower, filed a negligence lawsuit on behalf of his client, Joe S. in Citrus County, Florida in 2019. During the week of February 10, 2020, Mr. Hightower tried the case in Citrus County Circuit Court. After the conclusion of the trial, a verdict was rendered by the Court in favor of Joe S. and against the Defendant SUV driver for \$9,661,232.98.

When asked for comment on the verdict, Mr. Hightower simply said two things: 1) “Justice was served” and 2) “Watch out for motorcycles.”

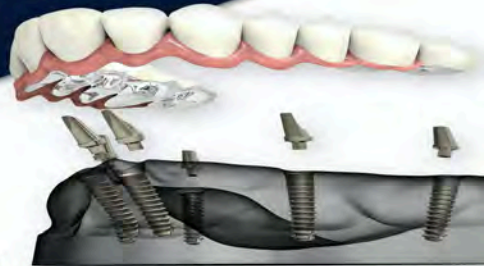

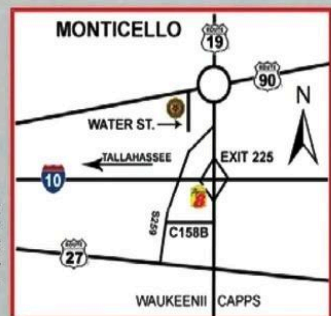

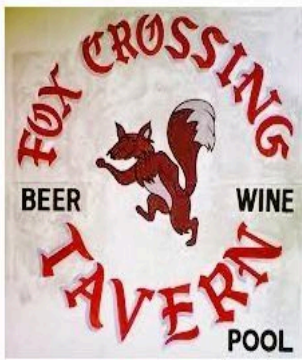
